Design meets technology 28 mm double cylinder is fully system compatible!

Architecture in its urbane and sophisticated aspect no longer needs to dispense with aesthetics and design, particularly in the case of glass doors. The new KESO short cylinder 4000S measures just 28 mm and is a fully system-compatible double cylinder in the tried and tested reversible key technology. It can be integrated in patented KESO 4000S Ω locking systems. The patent will continue to run until 2023.

The KESO short cylinder is based on the tried and tested technology of KESO System 4000. The complex challenges presented by a cylinder with minimum dimensions of just 28 mm have resulted in a refined product completely different from the system used up to now. Preferred areas of use for short cylinders are objects of urbane and sophisticated character, and this poses particular aesthetic and design-oriented demands. The new cylinder compensates for the distracting quality of protruding locking cylinders. The KESO short cylinder has been designed for ordinary locks with euro-profile section and can be individually adapted to the chosen lock fittings. Naturally it can be separately extended on both sides with faceplates in lengths of 2, 4, 6 and 14 mm. The minimum installation length of 28 mm consists of the basic cylinder (24 mm) and faceplates on both sides with a length of 2 mm. The faceplates are finished as standard in "satin nickel" for stainless steel fittings and "matt chrome" for aluminium surfaces. The range is extended with "polished chrome" and "gold décor", in order to give glass doors that classy touch.

KESO short cylinders are also suitable for sliding and folding doors and folding partitions, and unite discreet elegance with uncompromising security.
